



Site of Midewiwin ceremonies in the earlier years which went on until the late thirties.

- Was used for camping in the late sixties to early seventies.
- Continues to be used for Midewiwin ceremonies since its revival in 1976.
- Designated in the care of Three Fires Midewiwin Society by Band Council Resolution.
- There are songs that go with the land.
- Dakota Ojibway Child and Family Services have used the grounds for their Family and Clan gatherings.
- Red River Métis Journey with Red River Cart Ride camped here in 2002 for the North American Indigenous Games.
