SOLID LINE: TRANS CANADA TRAIL / CROW WING TRAIL IDENTIFIED BY BLUE SIGNS WITH WHITE ARROWS

DASHED LINE: LOOP TRAIL - NOT SIGNED

Access Point: A St-Malo Provincial Park Main Parking

Directions: PTH 59 South to St-Malo; follow signs east to St. Malo Provincial Park on Beach Road

Length: 2.6 miles or 4.2 kms

Description: Walk towards town (west) using the paved path, cross red bridge then Hwy 59 on south side of intersection. Continue on sidewalk and turn south (left) on St. Malo St. Turn east (left) on Benoit St. then cross Hwy 59. Turn north (left) and take path in ditch back to Beach Rd. and Access Point.

History: *In 1958, a dam over the Rat River was built to provide a consistent flow of water to surrounding towns and farms. In 1961, St. Malo Provincial Park was designated to provide camping, beaches and day-use facilities. *Father Noret built the grotto to thank "Our Lady of Lourdes" for a miracle which saved his life.
